Over 1/3 of the Gospels details this one week in Jesus life leading up to his death on the cross.

### **Chronological Outline of the Holy Week**

- Gospel of John: Half of it!... chapters 12 to 21
- Gospel of Mark: The best to look for each day of the Holy Week... chapters 11 to 16.
- Gospel of Matthew: Chapters 21 to 28
- Gospel of Luke: Chapters 19 to 24

- The Triumphal entry into Jerusalem (Mk.11:1-10)
- Jesus in Jerusalem and in the Temple (Mk.11:11)
- Retirement to Bethany (Mk.11:11)

#### **Monday:**

- The cursed fig tree withered to its roots. The power of prayer (Mk.11:20-26)

- The agony in Gethsemane and arrest of Jesus (Mk.14:32-50).

### **Good Friday:**

- Three religious (Jewish) trials of Jesus: Annas, Caiaphas, Sanhedrin (Jn.18:12-27, Lk.22:66-71).
- Three civic (Roman) trials of Jesus: Pilate, Herod, Pilate (Lk.23:1-25).
- The Way of the Cross (Mt.27, Mk.15, Lk.23, Jn.25).
- The Crucifixion of Jesus at 9 AM (Mk.15:25).
- The Death of Jesus at 3 PM (Mk.15:33-34).
- The burial of Jesus (Mk.15:42-37).

### **Saturday:**

The Bible says nothing, but tradition says it was the day when the Apostles went to give their condolences to the Mother of Jesus, and that's why the scattered Apostles were again together on Eastern Sunday when Jesus appeared to them.
